From the Pastor:

1 Peter 1:18-19 continues the thought of verse 17, "knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver and gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot."

We do not think about the word "redeem" very often. If we do we usually think of it in the context of taking an item purchased back to the store to "redeem" it, i.e. to receive back the purchase price, or to redeem coupons.

However, in the Greek of the New Testament it has a different meaning. The Greek word translated "redeemed" in this verse is the verb "lutroo." Lutroo is from the noun "lutron." From Danker's Lexicon "lutroo" has two definitions. The first is "to free by paying a ransom." The second is to liberate from an oppressive situation."

Danker's defines "lutron" as the "price of release, ransom." Therefore, "lutron" is that which is paid to effect a release or "lutroo."

This is what Jesus Christ accomplished by the shedding of His blood to death. His blood (or, His death that resulted from shedding His blood) redeemed us (ransomed us) from our captivity to Satan.

Mr. Armstrong wrote a booklet titled "A World Held Captive." It described the fact that humankind became the captives of Satan from the days of Adam and Eve. The "Christian" world does not recognize the fact that it has been following the ways and religion of "the god of this world" (2 Corinthians 4:4 KJV, or "the god of this age" NKJV) from those days when Satan influenced Adam and Eve to eat of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil and thus reject the instruction and teaching of God.

However, Jesus Christ came as the perfect sacrifice for sin whose blood enables us to "escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will." (2 Timothy 2:26) This liberation from the captivity of Satan is one of the truths Jesus said He came to do. Luke 4:18 reads, "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor...to preach deliverance to the captives..."

As we know death is the penalty of sin. (Romans 6:23) That penalty was paid for us by the death of Jesus Christ. His shed blood is what redeemed us (ransomed us) from our slavery (bondage) to sin and Satan. (Matthew 20:28; Revelation 5:9)

Jesus Christ was the perfect sacrifice for sin. He was indeed "a lamb without blemish." All sin offerings were to be animals without blemish (Leviticus 4:3, 23; Numbers 6:14; Ezekiel 43:22).

We were freed from death and our captivity to sin and Satan by the death and shed blood of
