

From the Pastor:

Before leaving 1 Peter 1:23 I want to use this verse to illustrate a principle in the Greek language that has been mentioned before. 1 Peter 1:23 says, “Having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible...”

The Greek word for “corruptible” is the adjective “phthartos.” “Phthartos” according to Danker’s Lexicon means “subject to decay/destruction, perishable.”

The Greek word for “incorruptible” (another adjective) is the same Greek root word with the prefix “a” added – “aphthartos.” “Aphthartos” as defined by Danker’s means “pertaining to imperviousness to corruption and death, imperishable...” In other words, “aphthartos” means not subject to decay/destruction.

We see this also in 1 Corinthians 15:53 which reads, “For this corruptible must put on incorruption...” Here “corruptible” is the same adjective “phthartos.” Whereas “incorruption” (Greek “aphtharsia”) comes from the noun form of the adjective and means (according to Danker’s) “the state of not being subject to decay...”

Whenever the prefix “a” is added to a root word the resulting word generally has the opposite meaning of the root word.

Human beings are corruptible. God is not. God is incorruptible. This is what Romans 1:23 is stating. “And changed the glory of the incorruptible [Greek “aphthartos”] God into an image made like corruptible [Greek “phthartos”] man...”

Human beings are made of matter. We are flesh, blood, and bone. When we die, we are subject to decay. We will return to the earth from which we were made. And, as 1 Corinthians 15:50 records, “Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption [Greek feminine noun “phthora”] inherit incorruption [Greek feminine noun “aphtharsia”]” we must undergo a change from being made of matter to being composed of spirit.


God is spirit (John 4:24). When we inherit incorruption we will become incorruptible spirit just like God. We will inherit life on the God-plane level of life.

Not being corruptible anymore does not (by itself) prove that we will be like God; but, the rest of 1 Corinthians 15:53 does. We will cover that next time.
