

From the Pastor

Jesus' message to His disciples continues in Matthew 6:1-4. "Take heed that you do not your charitable deeds before men, to be seen by them. Otherwise you have no reward from your Father in heaven. Therefore, when you do a charitable deed, do not sound a trumpet before you as the hypocrites do in the synagogues and in the streets, that they may have glory from men. Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward. But when you do a charitable deed, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, that your charitable deed may be in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will Himself reward you openly."

Instead of the phrase "charitable deeds" the KJV uses the word "alms." The Greek word translated "alms" or "charitable deeds" is "eleemosune" and is pronounced "el-eh-ay-mos-oo'-nay." Danker's Lexicon defines the word as "the exercise of benevolent goodwill... charitable giving." It can also refer what is given—the alms—"that which is benevolently given to meet a need." Therefore, the word can mean the act of giving or the gift itself.

Jesus said that the hypocrites give in order to be seen by men. It was more important to them to be seen by others doing these deeds. Their minds were on themselves instead of on those receiving the help.

That is the lesson Jesus was emphasizing. What we do for others must flow from a real concern for the needs of those individuals. We are not worrying in any way whether anyone else knows about what we are doing. In fact, we try to not let others learn about it—"that your charitable deed may be in secret."

The point is: God sees what is coming out of our hearts. Are we motivated by real love—real outgoing concern—for the needs of others. Or, are we looking for recognition and praise of men.

Jesus said an attitude motivated by real love will be rewarded by our Father. Real love describes God's own nature (1 John 4:8). He is pleased when He sees us seeking to live by that same love.

We need to learn to do good deeds because others are helped and for no other reason.
