

From the Pastor:

James 4:8 gives a promise of God, “Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.” The rest of the passage (the rest of verse 8 and then verses 9-10) we will cover next time.

All of God’s promises are absolute. The Bible is full of promises that He has given to His people. However, this is one of those promises that is very dear to God for it involves our seeking to build a relationship with Him. God created us because He wants a family relationship with us. He really wants us as His children. Those words don’t just express a “nice” sentiment. Those words express the true and actual motivation of God’s heart.

Please remember 2 Corinthians 6:17-18, “Therefore ‘come out from among them and be separate,’ says the Lord. ‘Do not touch what is unclean, and I will receive you. I will be a Father to you, and you shall be My sons and daughters,’ says the Lord Almighty.”

Perhaps it is hard for some of us to understand the depth of God’s love for us and the depth of His desire to have a close fatherly relationship with us because we have never experienced such love. But, His love and His desire are real. The coming Passover is a profound testimony to His and His firstborn Son’s love for us.

We all know that John 3:16 expresses the motivation of God’s—the Father’s—heart, “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.” 1 John 3:16 expresses the motivation of the Word’s—Jesus Christ’s—heart, “by this we know love, because He laid down His life for us...”

This is the reality. God really wants us to come to Him as children to a loving Father. Jesus expressed this on the night of that last Passover He ate with His disciples in John 16:23, 27, “And in that day you will ask Me nothing, Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you...for the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have believed that I came from God.”

God truly wants to see His children seeking to draw close to Him.

Seeking to draw close to God starts with a motivation of our heart to really want to build a relationship with our Father. That motivation of heart leads us to study God’s word because we want to learn about our Father and what He wants us to do. That motivations leads us to pour out our hearts in prayer to our Father asking for spiritual eyes that can see Him and the ways He wants us to live more clearly. We then meditate on what we are studying so we can live by those truths. We fast. We deny the self for the purpose of seeing our Father.

If our Father sees in us a real desire to “hunger and thirst for righteousness” (Matthew 5:6), then He promises that we “shall be filled” with righteousness. God will reveal Himself more clearly to our minds. He will draw near to us.
