

From the Pastor

Before the Feast of Unleavened Bread began Mr. Franks sent out several pages of statistics and comments from visitors to the Life, Hope & Truth website.

In March of this year 1,029,363 unique visitors came to the LHT site. A unique visitor is an individual who visited the site at least once in the month. They may have visited the site more than once in the month (e.g. 30 times); but, they were only counted as one unique visitor.

For comparison, LHT was launched in June of 2012. In that month there were just over 6,000 unique visitors. In March of 2014 there were only 90,310 unique visitors. Just two years later there were over one million unique visitors.

In the next few weeks I will list several of the comments from visitors to the LHT site. Those comments begin below:
