

From the Pastor

With over one million unique visitors in March to the LHT website there are an increasing number of people responding to what they read and learn. It is encouraging to see the impact that information has in the lives of some of those readers. With the growth of the readership we see Matthew 28:19-20 being fulfilled:

“Go therefore and make disciples [learners or pupils] of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age. Amen.”
