

From the Pastor

In the webinar on Sunday, May 15 after Mr. Franks presentation Mr. Clyde Kilough gave some updates on the work of the Media Department.

If you remember March's Internet activity (measured in unique visitors) was over one million – April's unique visitors numbered in the upper 900,000s. A trend has now been noticed concerning when people connect with the LHT website. On Wednesdays and Wednesday evenings there is a spike in visitors to the LHT website. No reason for this activity could be given.

We have also seen an increase in the number of email requests coming in this year compared to last year. These email requests contain questions from readers of the website and are answered by the PCD team. Year to date (through April) there had been 829 email requests in 2015. In 2016 for the same time period there were 1176. This represents a 42% increase in email requests over last year.

Mr. Kilough then mentioned that the next booklet is nearing completion and should be ready to be mailed to the membership by this year's Feast of Tabernacles. The booklet will cover the material about the U.S. and B.C. in prophecy though an exact title has not yet been determined. It will be the largest booklet produced so far – somewhere between 100 and 200 pages in length.

The next video series that will be produced will be on the Sabbath and presented by Mr. David Johnson.

The encouraging news is that on several fronts the reach and scope of the Work is increasing.

The next presenter was Mr. Doug Horchak giving an update on Ministerial Services. He also gave a number of statistics.

- Worldwide attendance (1st DUB) was 10,326*
- U.S. attendance (1st DUB) was 5,147
- Congregations worldwide – 242*
- Congregations in U.S. – 107
- Total Elders – 209*
- Pastors worldwide – 69*
- U.S. pastors – 44

*Worldwide figures include U.S. figures.
