

From the Pastor

As of this Sabbath we are less than 10 days away from the beginning of the seventh month on God's Sacred Calendar. Of course, we know that the first day of the seventh month is the Feast of Trumpets. The feasts of the seventh month which end with the 8th day (Leviticus 23:39) picture events that are yet to take place—or, as Paul put it they “are a shadow of things to come...” (Colossians 2:17).

These feasts picture the events which are a culmination of God's plan to have sons and daughters born into His family. Please meditate on that awesome truth. To us, to whom time means so much, God's plan seems to stretch into the vast recesses of history. But, to God, to whom a day is as a thousand years and a thousand years is as one day (2 Peter 3:8), the “time” is so very brief.

The Father is very much looking forward to having His children with Him. And, Jesus Christ is very much looking forward to being with His brothers and sisters. They truly love us that deeply. However, to be in their family all they want us to do is learn to embrace (and make our own) the qualities of their character of love.

God the Father and Jesus Christ are grieved by all of the suffering, hatred and violence in this world. They created human life because they want humankind to become a part of their very family. They want us to learn from them the way to peace and happiness—the way of love; but, under Satan's influence man has only learned to practice the way of self.

When God had created Adam and Eve and finished the physical preparations for His plan to have a family by the end of the sixth day Genesis 1:31 records God's thoughts, “God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good...” God was excited and pleased about the thought of His children being born into His family.

But, sometime after the Sabbath (perhaps the very next day), Satan influenced Adam and Eve to rebel against their Creator. And those pre-Flood generations followed Satan's ways and turned to selfishness and evil—so much so, that God lamented in Genesis 6:6 that He “was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart.” Mankind (God's potential children) had chosen the way of death and destruction.
