Nisan 30 days, Iyar 29 days, Sivan 30 days, Pentecost 50 days after the Sabbath of DULB lyar 15-Ex.16:1-3,15 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ day of the second month is a Sabbath, allows the dates to be filled in. Sivan $5^{\text {th }}$ Ex. 19:1 this is the same day of the week as the exodus. According to Ex 16:30 and Ex 19 there are only enough day to bring us to the $5^{\text {th }}$ of Sivan which was a $5^{\text {th }}$ day of the week. Hence Pentecost or the Sabbath before Pentecost is about 3 days later.
