
## The Wave Sheaf Offering and Christ

Which Sabbath is used to begin the counting of Pentecost?



The Passover of Jesus' crucifixition occurred in 31 AD which fell on a Wednesday.

The seventy weeks prophecy in Daniel 9:27 indicates that He would be crucified in the midst of the week-Wednesday.

Jesus was buried shortly before sunset as the Passover was ending and the FDULB an annual Sabbath was beginning Jo 19:31, Luke 23:54-56.

would have been used to determine the wave sheaf offering the ceremony would have occurred on Friday morning, Christ would have still been in the tomb and not been able to fullfill the events of the wave sheaf. Therefore it is evident that the weekly Sabbath is the Sabbath used to deteremine the wave sheaf and from there the counting of Pentecost.

offered on the day after the weekly Sabbath Lev. 23:11, 16. Jesus Christ was three days and three nights in the grave, Mat. 12:40. This means He was resurrected on the Sabbath. He showed himself to the disciples on the 1st day of the week. He ascends to the Father that morning Jo. 20:17 at the same time the wave sheaf ceremony is taking place. Jesus Christ the first of the firstfruits was alive on the morning of the wave sheaf ceremony and fulfilled the requirements of the ceremony.
